Tractors with Plows to Highlight 'Old Iron' Exhibit at 2016 Empire Farm Days

Seneca Falls, NY. Fans of antique agricultural equipment, often called 'old iron,' will be treated to a display of International Harvester Tractors with plows in the spotlight at the 2016 Empire Farm Days held at Rodman Lott and Son Farms, 2973 State Route 414, Seneca Falls, NY.

Bellona International Harvester Antique Tractor Club President Howard Hemminger organizes the exhibit for the largest outdoor agricultural trade show in the Northeastern U.S. In May, Hemminger noted, "We already have several members getting plows ready for this year's exhibit."

Hemminger likes to remind people that the 2015 exhibit featured a rare lineup of four consecutively numbered Super MTA tractors on exhibit and three International Harvester trucks, two of late 1940s vintage and one 1960s edition.

The three-day, 300-acre Empire Farm Days also offer visitors an up-close look at all the latest modern farming equipment and vehicles on display and working in field demonstrations on the showgrounds. Ride and Drive experiences let visitors take wheel

loaders, backhoes and skidsteers; four-wheelers and utility vehicles, and skidsteers for a test run.

The NYS FFA Tractor Driving Safety Contest for FFA youth takes place on Thursday, August 9 at the show. Little ones can try their skills as part of the 3rd annual Empire Farm Days Kiddie Tractor Pull throughout each day of the show.
