No More Picking Rocks: 2018 Empire Farm Days Adds Stone Crushing Field Demonstration

Seneca Falls, NY. A serious stone problem on his farm made Charles Goubau mad enough to pound rocks and that is just what he did. After traveling the world without finding a stone picking solution, he created BUGNOT North America machinery that crushes stone to clear fields and convert pastures into cropland. Visitors to the August 7-9, 2018 Empire Farm Days will see the stone grinder and forestry mulcher at work in new field demonstrations at Rodman Lott and Son Farms in Seneca Falls, NY.

“We had one client tell us that what we did in two hours would have taken a rock rake, a rock picker, a backhoe and a crew of three guys eight hours to accomplish and there would still be stones to pick up and move,” said Goubau, president of La Gantoise, Inc.

BUGNOT representatives from Lefaivre, Ontario, Canada, will be at the show to talk about how the equipment works with tractors from 80 to 500 horsepower to create crush, grind, mulch and shred from rocks and forested land to depths.

Instructional demonstrations will take place daily at the show at Lot #901.
